## AUTOVIA, iSalvage to be parts partners

AUTOVIA, a provider of aftermarket e-commerce applications for repair shops and parts distributors, and iSalvage, an Internet-based procurement network for recycled and remanufactured automotive parts, announced an agreement in which iSalvage will provide recycled-- parts procurement capability to AUTOVIA.
